Congresswoman Hayes:

I am writing in support of the Community Health Center Association of Connecticut's (CHCACT) application for funds to build a health care workforce development training facility in the 5th congressional district. This training facility will vastly improve Connecticut's ability to enhance the quality of health care in the state. CHCACT is the Primary Care Association for Connecticut and they have provided considerable support to community-based health care workers in Connecticut for 32 years. Establishing a new training facility in Connecticut for health care workers, predominantly in support of non-profit employees, will enhance the delivery of high-quality primary care to Connecticut residents.
