OVERVIEW:

We invite you to learn about ACCESS Mental Health for Moms program, CT's new and free (funded by DMHAS) psychiatric consultation program for providers treating pregnant and postpartum women presenting with mental health and substance use concerns. The program provides real-time perinatal psychiatric consultation and individualized, case-based education to frontline perinatal practitioners over the phone regarding diagnostic clarification, psychopharmacology and counseling recommendations, resources, and referral support.

Dr. **Ariadna Forray**, the team's lead perinatal psychiatrist from Yale, will introduce the program and explain the process for enrollment, discuss training opportunities and answer questions. More information available at www.accessmhct.com/moms/.
