### **DETAILS:**

In this training Griffin Health Services/Griffin Hospital School of Allied Health Careers will upskill **Certified Medical Assistants** in vaccine administration.

The training will consist of the following 3 parts:

1. 24-hour online didactic learning to include:
  - Medical Assistant and provider scope of practice and roles in relation to vaccine administration
  - Roles of The Center for Disease Control (CDC) and Occupational Safety and Health Administration (OSHA)
  - Perform needle stick/sharps safety, incident reporting and infection control, and utilize all proper methods of Personal Protective Equipment effectively
  - The importance of patient education regarding vaccinations
  - Understand immunity and vaccine information including classifications, adverse reactions, and anaphylaxis
  - Rules of medication administration and properly prepare medication for injections, dosages and vaccine administration
  - Identifying parts of a syringe and needle, needle lengths and gauges, and evaluate appropriate sites for safe vaccine administration
  - Effectively administer intradermal, subcutaneous and intramuscular injections
  - The importance of vaccine storage protocols and quality control
  - Chart and coordinate routine vaccination schedules
2. 4-hour equipment use (to be held at CHC/ACT July 25th)
3. 4-hour hands on site verification (locations and dates TBD)
